

You will need a Phillips screwdriver for drawer handle assembly.




ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1


Two people are recommended for ease of assembly.

Lay DRAWER W/ BAMBOO TOP (A) on its side on a smooth flat surface. Attach (2) LEGS (C) on same side to DRAWER W/ BAMBOO TOP (A) using (8) WASHERS (H) and (8) BOLTS (I) as shown. Then attach (2) SHELVES (B) using (8) WASHERS (H) and (8) BOLTS (I).

Note: The end with a steel plate welded is




△ Only hand tighten BOLTS (I). Do not fully tighten until Step 2.




STEP 2

Carefully turn over partially assembled unit from step 1 onto other side. Repeat step 1 to attach remaining (2) LEGS (C).

Put assembled cart upside down as shown. Fully tighten all (32) BOLTS (I) with provided HEX KEY (J).






ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 3

Screw each CASTER (F & G) into threaded nut at bottom of each leg. Turn clockwise to screw in place. Make sure LOCKING CASTERS (G) are on same side.


Note: Use provided WRENCH (K) to tighten all casters completely. Failure to do as instructed could result in caster stem breaking.


Stand cart right side up.




STEP 4

Attach DRAWER HANDLE (D) to drawer face with (2) HANDLE SCREWS (E) using a Phillips screwdriver.









USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

DRAWER REMOVAL

Pull drawer out so that it is almost fully extended. On LEFT-hand side, pull black release lever UP. On RIGHT-hand side, push black release lever DOWN. While holding the levers as instructed, pull drawer forward until released from slides attached to cart ("Cart Slides").

Note: Slides attached to drawer ("Drawer Slides") are an integral part of drawer and must be removed along with drawer itself.



DRAWER REPLACEMENT

To replace drawer, pull slides out completely. Insert brackets on each side of Drawer Slides into corresponding slots on Cart Slides, making sure they are properly positioned. Once brackets are inserted into slots, completely close drawer to set all slides in their proper positions.




USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

SHELF HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT

Height of middle shelf can be adjusted. Before adjusting, ensure all items have been removed from bamboo top, drawer and shelves.


Unscrew (8) BOLTS (I) and (8) WASHERS (H), unfastening middle shelf from legs. Tilt middle shelf diagonally to move it up or down to your desired height. Attach middle shelf to LEGS (C) with (8) WASHERS (H) and (8) BOLTS (I). Fully tighten BOLTS (I) with provided hex key.

WARNINGS

- 1. Read and understand all instructions. Failure to follow all instructions may result in injury and / or damage.
- **2. Tighten all casters completely by using the wrench.** Failure to do as instructed could result in the caster stem breaking, thereby causing the product to collapse.
- 3. The warnings, cautions, and instructions discussed in this manual cannot cover all possible conditions or situations that may occur. The user must always be aware of the environment and ensure to use the product in a safe and responsible manner.
- **4.** Do NOT modify the product in any way. Unauthorized modification may impair the function and / or safety of the product, and may affect the life of the product. Any modifications will void product warranty.
- 5. Check for damaged parts. Before using this product, carefully check that all parts are in good condition, and that the product will operate properly and perform its intended function. Check for damaged parts and any other conditions that may affect the operation of this product. Replace damaged or worn parts, and never use this product with a damaged part.
- 6. Do NOT overload the product.

- **7.** Do NOT allow children to climb or play around the product. Tipping may occur causing injury.
- 8. Do NOT stand or lean on the product or use any part of this product as a step ladder. Tipping may occur causing injury.
- **9.** Do NOT roll the product on an uneven surface. Only move the product on a smooth surface. Rolling over rough or uneven surface may cause casters to break or items on the product to fall, resulting in injury and / or damage.
- **10. Wood and laminate flooring can be scratched or dented.** Ensure your flooring can bear the weight of loaded product before rolling loaded product across your flooring.

WARNINGS

11. Lock all locking casters when leaving the product in stationary position.

12. Make sure that the casters are LOCKED when using the bamboo top as a cutting or work surface.

- 13. Load the product evenly and place the heaviest items on the lower shelves.
- 14. Do NOT leave knifes or sharp objects on the bamboo top unattended.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Avoid harsh, abrasive cleaners, and other corrosive chemicals.
- Bamboo top can be cleaned with damp cloth and wiped dry immediately with dry cloth.
- Clean up any spills immediately to prevent stains from forming on bamboo top.
- Do not put hot items directly on bamboo top to prevent damaging and discoloring bamboo surface.
- The product is designed for indoor use. outdoor use is not recommended.

1 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

Trinity International Industries ("Trinity") warrants to the original consumer purchaser ("Purchaser") of the TRINITY Ecostorage [®] 25" Bamboo and Stainless Steel Kitchen Cart w/ Drawer ("Product") that each Product shall be free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of 1 year from the date of original purchase. Trinity's obligation under this warranty shall be limited to repair or replacement of, or adequate compensation for the Product which shall not be greater than the amount of the purchase price of the Product, at the option of Trinity, during the warranty period. All replaced parts and Products become the property of Trinity and must be returned to Trinity.

This warranty excludes normal wear and tear of the Product and its parts or components, and damage arising from any of the following: negligent use or misuse of the Product, use contrary to this User's Manual, or alteration by any one other than Trinity. The warranty period of 1 year shall not be extended or renewed by the repair or replacement of, or compensation for, the Product.
