



You will need drill, level, and stud finder for assembly. These are NOT included.







BEFORE INSTALLATION

Two people are recommended for ease of assembly. Before you begin, remember to always work safely, follow tool manufacturers safety instructions.

Notes:

- TRINITY slatwall panels are designed to install over studs and properly studded drywall. For other surfaces please consult a local professional.
- To support claimed weight capacity:
 - Wall studs must be maximum 16" apart.
 - Each slatwall panel must be mounted on at least 3 studs.

SLATWALL CONFIGURATION

- SLATWALL PANELS (A) can be installed vertically from floor to ceiling or horizontally from left to right.
- EDGE TRIM (B) can be used to finish edges of panels.
- H TRIM (C) can be used to join panels side by side.
- Plan out your slatwall layout before proceeding.
- If your configuration requires cutting panels or trims, follow below instructions.





CUTTING SLATWALL PANEL AND TRIM


SLATWALL PANEL (A) and TRIM (B + C) can be cut easily to size you want, using any traditional wood working tools. Cleanest cuts can be achieved with a 32 tooth, or larger carbide blade, or blades used to cut medium density fiber board and laminates.


STEP 1

Pick location and coverage you want prior to installing your slatwall panels. If studs are covered by drywall, use a stud finder to mark locations of studs. Using a stud finder, locate all studs between start and finish, and mark along their length with a level. You will need to screw each panel into each stud.




STEP 2


Make a level line at bottom of your desired location for bottom slatwall.




STEP 3

Install your bottom EDGE TRIM (B) at desired starting height (wider side installs against wall), level and put (1) SCREW (D) into each stud.









STEP 4

Make sure SLATWALL PANEL (A) has correct side up.




Place first SLATWALL PANEL (A) into bottom EDGE TRIM (B) and confirm slatwall is level and plumb.

Secure SLATWALL PANEL (A) to wall by driving (6) SCREWS (D) through channels on front face of panel, directly into center of every wall stud as shown.




STEP 5

Place second SLATWALL PANEL (A) on top of first panel. Make sure top panel properly overlaps and nests over bottom panel. Push down on top panel to ensure it is properly seated. Confirm that panel is level and aligned with bottom panel.



Screw panel in place into center of every wall stud as shown.


Continue adding panels until you reach top of your desired height.



STEP 6




Finish side edge by overlapping your vertical EDGE TRIM (B) with your horizontal edge trim at bottom (wider side against wall). Insert edge of slatwall inside EDGE TRIM (B). Push edge trim onto panel to finish side edge.



STEP 7

To finish top edge, place EDGE TRIM (B) on top of slatwall by inserting edge of slatwall inside EDGE TRIM (B). Push down on EDGE TRIM (B) to cap edge of top panel.





STEP 8





If you are adding another column of panels, use H TRIM (C) to join next column. If you are done, skip to STEP 9.

C (1)

Cut H TRIM (C) to fit between top and bottom trims. Keeping flat side of H TRIM (C) against wall, push opening onto edge of panel.

Repeat STEP 3, 4, 5 and 7 to install another column of panels.






STEP 9

Finish last side edge by inserting edge of slatwall inside EDGE TRIM (B). Push edge trim onto panel to finish side edge.




HOOK USAGE

HOOK INSTALLATION




Place each HOOK (E/F/G/H/I/J) onto slatwall by inserting top edge of hook into channel of slatwall and then pushing bottom locking portion in until you hear a click.

Make sure HOOK (E/F/G/H/I/J) is secured to slatwall tightly before hanging anything on it.




HOOK REMOVAL

You can remove HOOK (E/F/G/H/I/J) from slatwall by first pressing down black locking tab on hook then pulling out bottom of hook before disengaging entire HOOK (E/F/G/H/I/J).




MESH BAG INSTALLATION

Attach BAG HOOKS (K) onto slatwall following hook installation instructions in previous page. Make sure distance between bag hooks match MESH BAG (L) width.




Hang MESH BAG (L) onto BAG HOOKS (K) by inserting inner arm of each hook through sleeve on left and right




MESH BAG USAGE

For ease of reaching item at bottom of bag without removing items above it, zip up to open mesh bag.


Zip down to close mesh bag.





WIRE SHELF USAGE

WIRE SHELF INSTALLATION




Attach SHELF SUPPORT (M) onto slatwall following hook installation instructions in previous page. Make sure distance between two SHELF SUPPORTS (M) is narrower than WIRE SHELF (N) width.

Making sure TRINITY logo is front facing and right-side-up. Attach WIRE SHELF (N) onto SHELF SUPPORTS (M) by positioning middle horizontal wire of WIRE SHELF (N) right in front of slots of SHELF SUPPORTS (M).

With both hands in position as shown, pressing middle horizontal wire into slots while holding up front of WIRE SHELF (N) with your thumbs. You will hear a click when WIRE SHELF (N) is secured in place.


WIRE SHELF REMOVAL


You can remove WIRE SHELF (N) by pulling up and away from rear of WIRE SHELF (N).



BIN INSTALLATION

Hang 7" BIN (O) / 13" BIN (P) onto slatwall panel by inserting lip of 7" BIN (O) / 13" BIN (P) into channel of slatwall.

WARNINGS

- 5. Slatwall must be installed onto wall studs. It is the responsibility of the installer to ensure that wall mounting surface and structure are sufficient in strength and capacity to support slatwall weight and its contents. Failure to observe these conditions may result in damage, injury or death.
- 6. Installation of slatwall panel should be in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.
- 7. Do NOT overload the product. Overload could result in property damage, serious injury or death. Below capacity is based on evenly distributed weight.

Weight capacity per bin	7" bin: 6 lb 13" bin: 10 lb
Weight capacity per single hook and bag hook	20 lb
Weight capacity per mesh bag	30 lb
Weight capacity per double hook, loop hook and wire shelf	50 lb
Weight capacity per square foot of slatwall panel (properly mounted with evenly distributed weight)	75 lb

- 8. Do NOT allow children to hang or pull hooks that have been inserted onto the slatwall. Damage may occur causing injury.
- 9. Do NOT place any direct heat source on or near the slatwall.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Avoid harsh, abrasive cleaners, and other corrosive chemicals.
- Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight to prevent discoloration and / or deformation.
- Keep clean with water and mild detergent. Do NOT use scouring pad for cleaning.
- Hand wash the mesh bag only. Do NOT bleach, iron or dry clean the mesh bag. Dry flat only.
 Do NOT wring or rub.
- The product is designed for indoor use.
- Check regularly to ensure screws have not loosened during use of slatwall.
- Check regularly to ensure hooks are secure before each use.

Trinity International Industries ("Trinity") warrants to the original consumer purchaser ("Purchaser") of the TRINITY 64 Sq Ft Modular Slatwall 40-Piece Accessory Ultimate Set ("Product") that each Product shall be free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of 1 year from the date of original purchase. Trinity's obligation under this warranty shall be limited to repair or replacement of, or adequate compensation for the Product which shall not be greater than the amount of the purchase price of the Product, at the option of Trinity, during the warranty period. All replaced parts and Products become the property of Trinity and must be returned to Trinity.

This warranty excludes normal wear and tear of the Product and its parts or components, and damage arising from any of the following: negligent use or misuse of the Product, use contrary to this User's Manual, or alteration by any one other than Trinity.
