





ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1






STEP 2

Align holes in BOTTOM SHELF (C) with bottom of LEG (D), making sure that shelf lip is facing TUB (A). Screw LOCKING CASTER (J) into bottom of LEG (D), securing BOTTOM SHELF (C) in between. Make sure LOCKING CASTERS (J) are installed on same side. Repeat to install NON-LOCKING CASTERS (K) on other side.

Tighten CASTERS (J + K) completely with provided WRENCH (L).

<u>Use provided caster wrench to tighten</u> <u>completely. Failure to do as instructed could</u> <u>result in caster stem breaking.</u>


STEP 3

B (2) F (8) M (1)

Turn cooler right side up.

Loosen LARGE SCREWS (F) that are preinstalled on side of TUB (A). Hang SIDE SHELF (B) on LARGE SCREWS (F) by inserting LARGE SCREWS (F) into mounting holes of SIDE SHELF (B).

With SIDE SHELF (B) in up position, check to ensure shelf bracket is seated fully on mounting holes. Tighten LARGE SCREWS (F) from underside of SIDE SHELF (B) with provided SCREWDRIVER (M).





ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 4

Attach BOTTLE OPENER (H) to TUB (A) front using SMALL SCREWS (E).

Attach CAP CATCHER (G) to TUB (A) front by sliding it down on metal notch.






STEP 5

Unscrew DRAIN PLUG (I) assembly. Insert DRAIN PLUG (I) through opening in TUB (A) from inside. Make sure rubber seal is on **inside** of TUB (A).

From <u>outside</u>, slide Washer on first, then second Washer with Chain, and then screw on Nut. Be sure not to overtighten. Once DRAIN PLUG (I) is in place, screw on Cap.




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
USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

Folding and Unfolding Side Shelf

Fold SIDE SHELF (B) by using both hands and lifting SIDE SHELF (B) up until slots on SIDE SHELF (B) disengaged from bottom screws on bracket of SIDE SHELF (B). Once disengaged, fold SIDE SHELF (B) down.




Unfold SIDE SHELF (B) by simply pulling SIDE SHELF (B) up with both hands then press down to ensure slots on bracket of SIDE SHELF (B) engages screws on bracket. Make sure SIDE SHELF (B) is secure before placing objects on it.



Install Cover

Make sure SIDE SHELVES (B) are folded down before putting on COVER (N).


Unfold COVER (N) and put it onto assembled cooler. Pull Velcro straps to secure COVER (N).

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WARNINGS

- **1. Read and understand all instructions.** Failure to follow all instructions may result in injury and/or damage.

- **3.** Use the provided caster wrench to tighten completely. Failure to do as instructed could result in the caster stem breaking thereby causing the product to collapse.
- **4. Do NOT modify the product in any way.** Unauthorized modification may impair the function and/or safety of the product and may affect the life of the product. Any modifications will void product warranty.
- **5.** Check for damaged parts. Before using this product, carefully check that all parts are in good condition, and that the product will operate properly and perform its intended function. Check for damaged parts and any other conditions that may affect the operation of this product. Replace damaged or worn parts, and never use this product with a damaged part.
- 6. Do NOT overload the product.

- 7. Do NOT let children climb or play in the product.
- 8. Lock the casters when leaving product in stationary position.
- **9. Do NOT push product on uneven surface.** Cooler may tip or tub may detach from the cart and casters may be loosened and damaged causing the cart to collapse.
- **10. Wood and laminate flooring can be scratched or dented.** Ensure your flooring can bear the weight of loaded product before rolling loaded product across your flooring.
- **11. Do NOT leave objects on side shelf when moving product.** Objects may fall causing damage and/or injury.
- Be careful when buckling lid close and folding or unfolding side shelf to avoid pinching and injury.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Remember to drain remaining water and remove un-melted ice after use. Wipe dry for storage.
- Avoid harsh, abrasive cleaners, and other corrosive chemicals.
- Do not use scouring pad for cleaning.
- Keep dry and avoid damp environments.
- Use a quality stainless steel cleaner and follow instructions that come with the cleaner.
 Wipe ALONG the grain (NOT against).
- Cooler should not be left out unprotected in the elements. Keep cover on when cooler is not in-use.
- Cover is made of 100% polyester with a coated backing, wipe it clean by wet towel or sponge with mild detergent where needed.
- Do NOT wash cover in hot water. Hand wash only in cold water, line dry in shade only. Do
 NOT wring or rub cover. Do NOT bleach, iron, dry clean or tumble dry cover.

1 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

Trinity International Industries ("Trinity") warrants to the original consumer purchaser ("Purchaser") of the TRINITY 80 Qt Stainless Steel Cooler w/ Foldable Side Shelf & Cover ("Product") that each Product shall be free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of 1 year from the date of original purchase. Trinity's obligation under this warranty shall be limited to repair or replacement of, or adequate compensation for the Product which shall not be greater than the amount of the purchase price of the Product, at the option of Trinity, during the warranty period. All replaced parts and Products become the property of Trinity and must be returned to Trinity.

This warranty excludes normal wear and tear of the Product and its parts or components, and damage arising from any of the following: negligent use or misuse of the Product, use contrary to this User's Manual, or alteration by any one other than Trinity. The warranty period of 1 year shall not be extended or renewed by the repair or replacement of, or compensation for, the Product. Any warranty implied by applicable law is limited in duration to one year from the date of purchase and is subject to the same conditions and limitations as is provided for our express warranty.
